Instructions

- ✓ 20 items, 5 factors (Item No.1~6=Compassionate interaction, 7~11=Respect, 12~14=Providing comfort, 15~17=Information sharing, 18~20=Nursing expertise).
- ✓ A 5-point Likert-type scale was used to measure PCPON (1 = Not at all ~ 5=Extremely).
- ✓ A high score means a high degree of person-centered perioperative nursing performance.
